
ANNUAL WRITTEN NOTIFICATION OF INTENDED PESTICIDE USE
AND INDIVIDUAL APPLICATION REGISTRY

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Novato Unified School District adopted a Least Toxic Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Policy approximately 17 years ago. The policy states that pests will be controlled to protect the health and safety of students and staff to maintain a productive learning environment and to maintain the integrity of the school buildings and grounds. It is the policy of the District to develop long-term pest prevention methods and give "non-chemical" methods first consideration when selecting appropriate control measures.

Parents or guardians may request prior notification of individual pesticide applications at school sites each year. People listed on this registry will be notified at least 72 hours before pesticides are applied. If pesticides are applied this school year, and you would like to be notified;

The Healthy Schools Act of 2000 requires all California school districts to notify parents and guardians of pesticides they expect will be applied during the upcoming year. We want to notify you that the following pesticides may be used at your School this year:

Delta Dust	Deltamethrin
Wasp Freeze	d-trans Allethrin, Phenothrin
Ranger Pro	Glyphosate
Round Up Pro	Glyphosate
