John Dilena, Project/Program Executive, Greystone West Company, presented California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) Contract for Procurement of Equipment for HVAC Replacement Project at Hamilton TK-8 School, San Marin High School, San Ramon Elementary School and Pleasant Valley Elementary School.

On September 19, 2023, Trustees approved the California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) contract for the HVAC equipment procurement for HVAC replacement projects at HamiltonTK-8 School, San Marin High

School, San Ramon Elementary School and Pleasant Valley Elementary School.

Equipment requirements and HVAC design has changed as the plans have progressed from the Schematic Design phase to the Construction Documents phase based on existing conditions and refined mechanical needs. As a result, the CMAS contract needs to be amended to increase the amounts at each site as follows:

- Hamilton TK-8 School increase of \$58,450.
- Pleasant Valley Elementary School increase of \$72,422.
- San Marin High School increase of \$31,357.
- San Ramon Elementary School increase of \$17,599.

The corrected total of the cost increases is \$179,828. The increased cost will come out of the contingency budget.

John Dilena, Project/Program Executive, Greystone West Company, presented the Schematic Design/Project Schedule/Project Cost Estimate for the Roofing Repair Project at Loma Verde Elementary School.

On December 3, 2019, Trustees approved allocating \$44.06 million from Measure G to Deferred Maintenance (DM) to address DM needs which included the roofing repair at the Loma Verde Elementary School.

District Staff, along with Greystone West Company, identified needs and developed a schematic design. The current total construction cost estimate for this project is \$1,626,000 with 10% contingency included. The goal is to start construction in mid-June 2024 and complete work by mid-August 2024.

(7:15 PM) Review and Approve Board Policy Updates in the 0000 (Philosophy, Goals, Objectives and Comprehensive Plans) Series (1) - First Reading

Dr. Julie Synyard, Executive Director of Education Services, presented updates to Board Policy 0500: Accountability as a first reading. Board Policy 0500 is in the 0000 (Philosophy, Goals, Objectives and Comprehensive Plans) series.

Board Policy 0500 was updated to reflect that the U.S. Department of Education declined the California Department of Education's (CDE) waiver request that would have allowed for the continued use of modified methods for calculating the Academic and Graduation Rate Indicators, resulting in the California School Dashboard no longer including any modified methods applied to state indicators and all Dashboard Alternative School Status schools being treated the same as all other schools on the Dashboard. Board Policy 0500 was also updated to

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reflect **NEW LAW (SB 114, 2023)** which (1) adds "long-term English learners," defined by **NEW LAW (SB 141, 2023)** as a student who has not attained English language proficiency within seven years of initial classification as an English learner, as a numerically significant subgroup, (2) creates a new basis for technical assistance when the district fails to meet specified data submission requirements, and (3) specifies when the California Collaborative for Educational Excellence (CCEE) will consult with the district and any provider of technical assistance to determine if assistance from CCEE is necessary.

Administrative Regulation 5131.41 was updated to clarify the limited exception when seclusion and/or behavioral constraint may be used, and to reflect that it cannot be applied for longer than necessary to contain the dangerous behavior. Administrative Regulation 5131.41 was also updated to include, as appropriate, concepts from the December 2022 Davis Joint Unified School District Resolution Agreement with the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights, regarding the use of seclusion and restraint as it relates to a free appropriate public education

for students with disabilities. A new section entitled: "Documentation of Seclusion and Restraint was also added.
